ORDER STAYING CASE

This Court has considered, without hearing, Defendants' consent motion to stay proceedings, ECF No. 44. This Court finds that there is good cause to stay this case because the rule being challenged by Plaintiffs does not take effect until February 6, 2020. ECF 44, at 1. Moreover, there are ongoing administrative proceedings that, if finalized, could moot this case. *Id.* at 1–2.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Defendants' consent motion to stay proceedings, ECF No. 44, is **GRANTED**.

2. This case shall be stayed for one year from the date of this order. The Defendants are directed to file status reports every 90 days regarding the status of Defendants' reconsideration of the 2015 Clean Water Rule and related rulemaking. The Defendants are also directed to promptly notify this Court and the parties upon the issuance of any further agency action on reconsideration.
