This memorandum discusses matters that will be coming before the membership during the online Annual Membership Meetings in June. It reviews the procedures for the election of the Florida Stormwater Association's (FSA) and the Florida Stormwater Association Educational Foundation's (FSAEF) Boards of Directors and FSA Officers. The Annual Membership Meetings and Elections will be held online this year for the first time. The meetings will begin June 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Eastern during the Friday morning of the Annual Conference with a Zoom Meeting. The meetings will officially conclude one week later on July 2, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. Eastern to allow time for electronic voting. 1. Call to Order

a) Welcome

The Annual Membership Meetings will be called to order and all will be welcomed.

b) Acknowledgements

A big thank you goes out to the Boards of Directors and Committees who have served FSA and FSAEF. We would not be where we are without the support of our volunteers. Join us in thanking the Boards of Directors and Committees.

2. FSAEF Board of Directors

a) Structure and Responsibilities

The FSAEF Board of Directors has general oversight responsibilities regarding the Educational Foundation's programs, which include the Scholarship Program and various research projects. All members of FSA are also members of FSAEF. The FSAEF Board of Directors meet twice a year.

The Board of Directors is comprised of FSA's Education Committee Chair and four additional members serving alternating two-year terms. At least one member shall be a Past President of FSA or have served in a leadership position. With the exception of the Education Committee Chair, FSAEF Board members may not be members of FSA's Board of Directors or be employed by an organization that is otherwise represented. Visit the FSA website for a <u>current list of the FSAEF Board of Directors</u>.

b) Nominations and Elections

Starting in February, information was distributed to the membership requesting recommendations for the FSAEF Board of Directors. There are currently two open seats. Visit the <u>FSA Elections page</u> for a list of eligible candidate information received prior to the April deadline. Additional nominations of qualified individuals will also be accepted from the floor during the Annual Membership Meeting (via Zoom on June 25, 2021 @ 9:00 a.m. Eastern).

Elections will occur in the online Zoom Meeting with electronic ballots. Please remember that membership is organizational, so only one vote per organization is allowed.

3. FSA Board of Directors

a) Structure and Responsibilities

The FSA Board of Directors has the responsibility for setting broad policy for the Association and approving its annual budget. Only Board members may serve as Committee Chairs. The Board of Directors meets quarterly.

b) Officer Nominations and Elections

The offices of President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer are elected by the membership. The three Officers and the Immediate Past President form the Executive Committee, which has the responsibility for working with staff and overseeing the routine operations of the Association. The Executive Committee may act on behalf of FSA. Members of the Executive Committee also serve on the Board of Directors.

The Association's Bylaws contain provisions intended to ensure that at least half of the Executive Committee's seats are filled by representatives of local governments that have a stormwater utility (SWU) or similar financing mechanism (SFM) including:

- No more than one Consultant representative and no more than one Water Management District representative may serve at the same time.
- The Executive Committee must include at least two representatives of cities or counties that have stormwater utilities or similar financing mechanism.

FSA President Kelli Hammer Levy appointed a Nominating Committee to make recommendations for persons to hold the Officer positions. The Committee was composed of Chair Tiffany Busby (Wildwood Consulting); Brett Cunningham (Jones Edmunds); Danielle Honour (CDM Smith); and Jim Hunt (City of Orlando).

The Nominating Committee makes the following recommendations:

Additional nominations of qualified persons for any of the Officer positions may be made from the floor during the Annual Membership Meeting (via Zoom on June 25, 2021 @ 9:00 a.m. Eastern).

Elections will occur in the online Zoom Meeting with electronic ballots. Please remember that membership is organizational, so only one vote per organization is allowed.

c) Board of Directors Nominations and Elections

There are **four categories of membership** on the Association's Board of Directors where vacancies will occur during the Annual Membership Meeting.

- Local Government/Special District Two representatives of local governments or special
 districts from within the boundaries of each of the five Water Management Districts are
 elected by their peers; however, at least one representative from each District area must be
 from a city or county with a stormwater utility (SWU) or similar financing mechanism (SFM).
 They serve staggered, two-year terms. One seat in each WMD area is open for election
 during the Annual Membership Meeting.
- Consultant Four Consultant members are elected by their peers for staggered, two-year terms. **Two seats are open for election** during the Annual Membership Meeting.
- Water Management District One Water Management District member is elected by their peers for a two-year term. One seat is open for election during the Annual Membership Meeting.

Starting in February, information was distributed requesting recommendations for members who are interested in becoming more active. Visit the <u>FSA Elections page</u> for a list of eligible candidate information received prior to the April deadline. Additional nominations of qualified individuals will also be accepted from the floor during the Annual Membership Meeting (via Zoom on June 25, 2021 @ 9:00 a.m. Eastern).

Elections will occur by electronic ballots until July 2, 2021, 5:00 p.m. Eastern time. Please remember that membership is organizational, so only one vote per organization is allowed.

In preparation for voting please visit the FSA website for a <u>current list of the FSA Board of Directors</u> <u>and terms</u>. Note there are no limitations or restrictions concerning the number of times current members of the Board may be re-elected.

An engaged, active, and high-functioning Board is critical to the continued success of the Association! Board members are expected to serve as ambassadors of and for the Association, helping to promote the Association and its programs. It is important that persons serving on the Board are committed to FSA and its mission and are able to devote the time and energy needed to participate in an effective manner. A description of Board Members' Duties and Expectations is attached to this memorandum.

While we realize that unforeseen circumstances may arise, we ask that you consider running for a seat on the Board only if you expect to be able to attend all of its meetings and participate as an active, engaged member.

We look forward to seeing you online at the Annual Membership Meeting on Friday, June 25th!

FLORIDA STORMWATER ASSOCIATION - DUTIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

Essential Duties

- 1. Prepare for and attend all Board meetings throughout the year.
- 2. Actively participate and contribute to the discussion in all Board meetings.
- 3. Disclose potential conflicts of interest and avoid personal agendas.
- 4. Respect the confidentiality of the Board, the Association and its members.
- 5. Protect the financial health of FSA by taking an active role in monitoring its budget.
- 6. Support the decisions of the Board and promote its policy objectives.
- 7. Provide assistance and support to committee chairs and the Executive Committee, regardless of committee assignment.

Expectations

Governance

Each Board member encourages a member to volunteer to serve on a committee prior to the June Business Meeting

Each Board member identifies at least one or two people in their area that would be good prospects to become more active in FSA

Education/Conference

Identify a suitable location to host at least one Training Center class within your Training Center Region every year.

Promote all Training Center classes in your region.

Promote recognition of certifications provided by the Training Center within your jurisdiction's position descriptions or personnel policies.

Contact at least four individuals that have not registered for a conference two months prior to the winter and annual conferences.

Contact at least one potential sponsor or product/service provider at least three months prior to the winter and annual conferences to ensure that they are aware of the opportunity to sponsor or exhibit.

Membership

Promote membership by reaching out to at least two potential new members or non-renewing former members each quarter, with at least double that number if you are on the Membership Committee.

Legislative/Agency

Keep abreast of state legislative activities and contribute to FSA position papers.

Advocate for FSA's legislative objectives by engaging your superiors or your jurisdiction's elected officials in support of FSA's programs, making them aware of the value of such programs.

Encourage your jurisdiction's decision-makers to include positions formulated by FSA in their legislative policies.

Contact the members of your legislative delegation in support of FSA positions during the legislative session.


